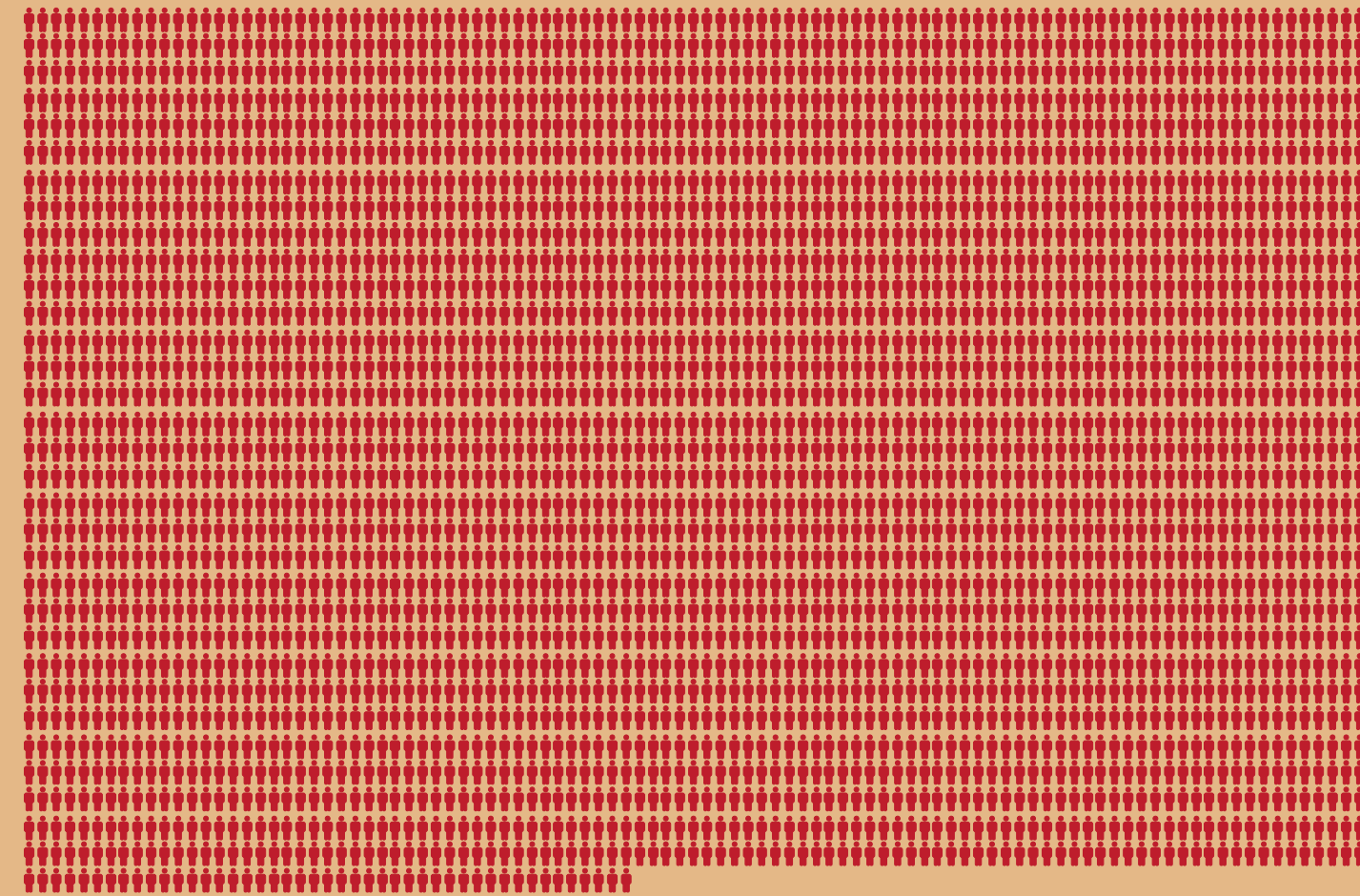


+THE DRONES

- + EACH DRONE IS EQUIPPED WITH UP TO 14 HELLFIRE MISSILES AND 2 LASER-GUIDED BOMBS
- + DRONES CAN COST BETWEEN TWO AND EIGHT MILLION DOLLARS
- + DRONE STRIKES IN PAKISTAN ARE USUALLY CONTROLLED BY MILITARY PERSONNEL IN THE UNITED STATES

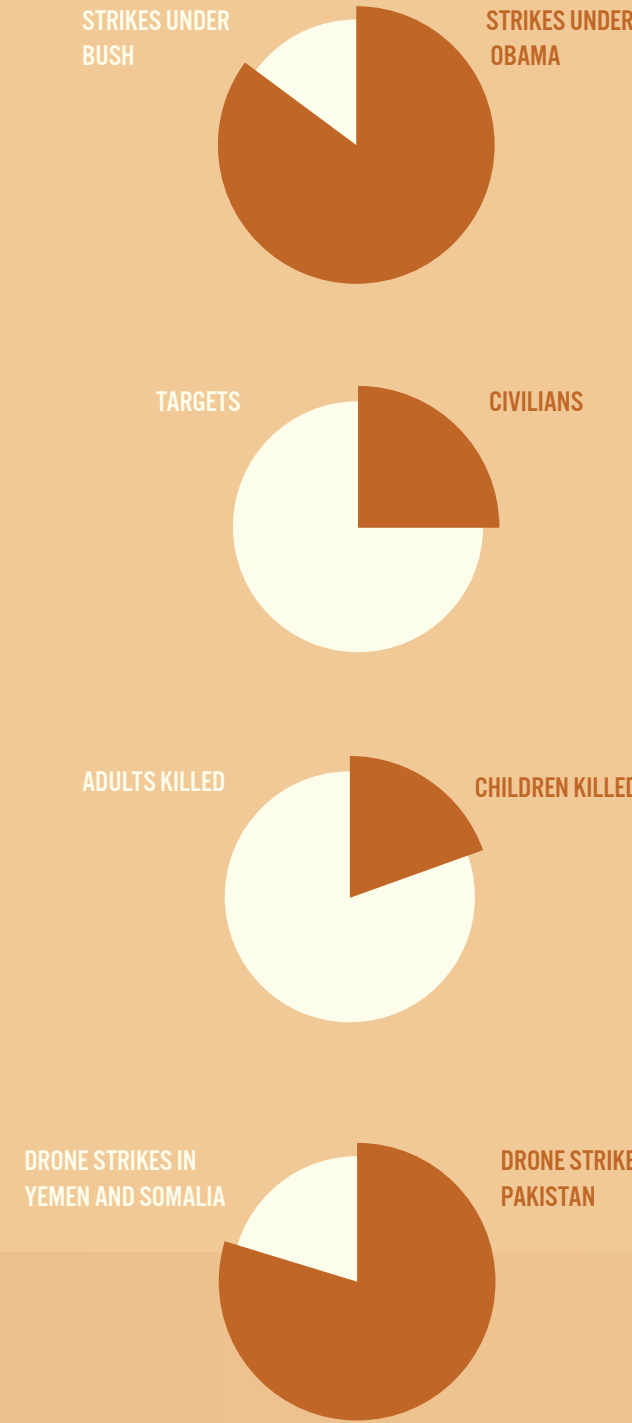

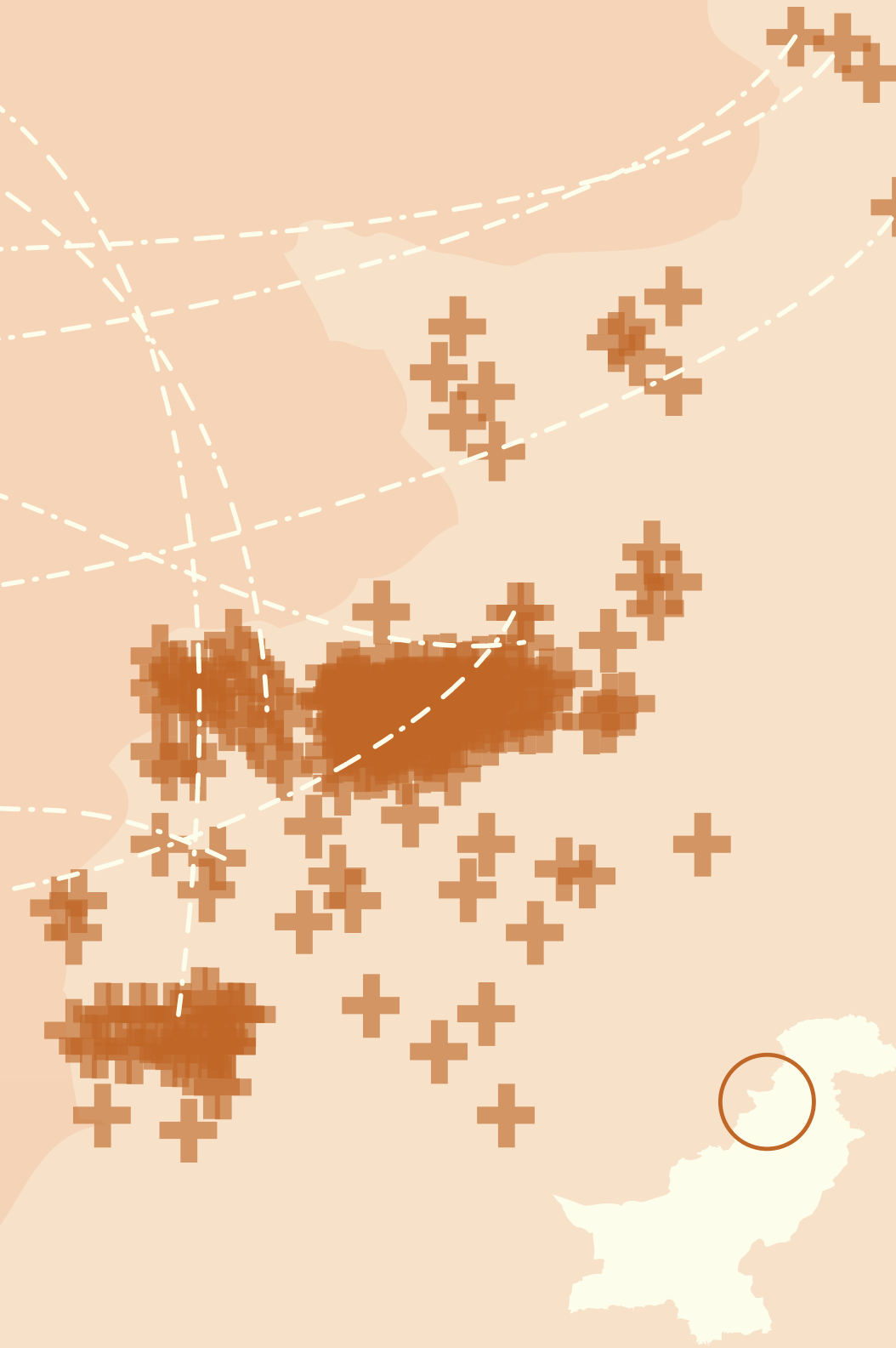

- APRIL 22ND 2011 | TIME UNKNOWN | 26 DEAD | 2 INJURED

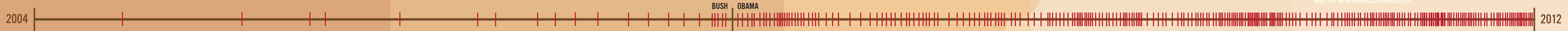
